kdy mu řekneš, ať jde,

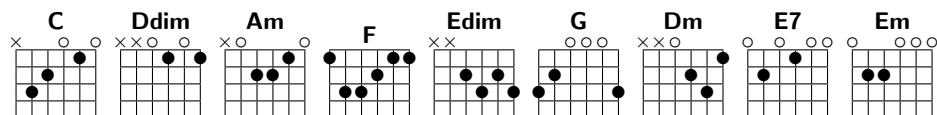
že dal to, zač si myslel, žes stál.
